
EMPLOYEES WORKING FROM HOME IN 2021 – CLIENT DOCUMENT

Many employees will be able to claim a deduction on their 2021 personal tax return for work space in home expenses. Follow the steps below as a simplified guide to assist in determining your claim.

STEP 1 - ELIGIBILITY AND CHOOSING A METHOD



STEP 2 – SIMPLIFIED CHART (TEMPORARY FLAT RATE METHOD)

A) Did you work from home more than 50% of the time for at least four consecutive weeks in 2021 due to COVID-19? YES / NO

B) If Yes, total number of days (250 days max.) you worked from home (full or part time) in 2021 due to COVID-19: ____
